# Conditional Admission Policy Research

### Clemson University

An admission status of % § } v ] šnjeansotbeÇapplicant needs to complete specified conditions within two semesters (or on an alternate timeline specified by the program) of enrollment prior to full admissionor ditionally admitted student is not officially admitted to the university or to a degree program until all conditions are met. Until all conditions are met, students will be classified as degree students. Specified conditions may include, but are not mitted to: completing an English language proficiency program and/or completing additional academic requirements. Once the specified conditions are met, the student must reapply to the program to be granted fully admitted status.

## University of Tennesse€ystem

Students not admitted to a degree program may be admitted undergree or provisional statusNon-degree is for applicants who wish to take graduate classes, but do not wish to pursue a degree program. A student may be admitted under the ipnavistatus for one semester or for one course in each of two semesters.

## College of Arts, Sciences, and Engineering

## Master of Arts Degree in English

At the discretion of the department's graduate admissions committee, applicants may be admitted or conditional status subject to attainment of grades which inchedenore than three semester hours of C and no grades lower than C on the first three græduaturses (nine semester hours) or which enrolled and other conditions deemed appropriate by the committee to address applicant's specific weaknesses.

Any applicant failing to meet the requirements for unconditional admission NVCSCJ program may beconditionally admitted with recommendations of the graduate faculty in the Department of Politics, Justice, Law, and Philoso/phylicants granted conditional admittance must achieve a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the first nine houlns (te courses) of completed graduate coursework. Failure to make this GPA requirement will result in the student being eliminated from the program.
